

AMIKids, Inc. is a national organization that provides educational and behavioral services to youth who have been involved with or are at risk of entering the justice system using the evidence-based, AMIKids Personal Growth Model®. In calendar year 2019, AMIKids served youth across 222 counties in 10 states at 44 unique programs.



4,812 youth were impacted by AMIKids services



Average length of engagement was 188 days, and ranged from 4-9 months

## Challenges Experienced by Our Youth

All youth are assessed when they enter our programming to identify specific needs and strengths of the youth and their family. This information is critical for AMIKids to provide individualized care for each youth to meet their specific goals and plans. Despite these challenges, 83% of youth show motivation for treatment and are open to receive services.

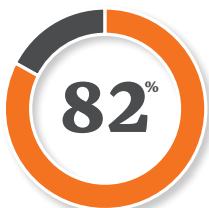

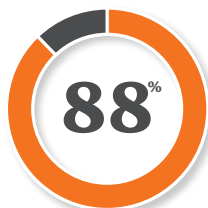

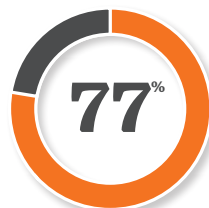
## Youth Success
